

Before Spring Semester begins all TRC participants that have not been assessed will need to schedule an appointment before registering. Participants that were assessed before Spring Semester 2017 will need to be re-assessed. Reassessments must be done every two years for current participants to identify improved functional abilities and new leisure interest. During the assessment a level of functional ability will be determined for each participant. Participants are only allowed to register for programs that are offered for their functional ability. Please note that many programs have a limit for participation which is on a first come, first serve basis. However this does not apply to team sports or clubs whereby a participant has been in for years. If your child is interested in a team sport or club please call the contact person for that program.
