How your pharmacy benefits work

You may need medicine for a very short time to treat something like an infection. Or, you may need to take medicine for a long time to treat a condition like diabetes. Either way, your pharmacy benefit plan could help you save money.

How your coverage works

Visit AlabamaBlue.com/druglist to check the list of medicines covered under your pharmacy benefits (called a **formulary**). Doctors and pharmacists have carefully selected the generic and brand name drugs on the list. Drugs that aren't on this list may cost you more.

For covered medicines, the amount that you pay is called your **copay**, or cost share. Your pharmacy benefit plan pays the rest.

How could you save with home delivery?

We can help you save with the PrimeMail by Walgreens Mail Service which is part of your Home Delivery Network, or with generic medicines that can **save you up to 85%**.¹ If you take a brand-name drug, ask your doctor or pharmacist about generic drugs — a lower-cost version of a brand-name drug. It works the same as the brand-name drug in safety, strength and effectiveness.

Order your long-term medicine from Walgreens Mail Service. Receive up to a 90-day supply of your medicine anywhere in the U.S.
