Consent for Use of Permitted Establishment as a Commissary

According to Chapter 420-3-22-.09 (6) of the Alabama Department of Public Health Rules for Food Establishment Sanitation, "Mobile food units or pushcarts shall operate from a commissary or other fixed food service establishment and shall report at least daily to such location for all supplies and for all cleaning and servicing operations". The commissary must be a permitted establishment that has been approved for this use by the local Health Department. The commissary is to be used as a base of operations to: collect potable water, discharge waste water, discharge solid waste, store supplies, and clean and service the mobile unit. A servicing area must be provided. Within this servicing area, there shall be a location provided for flushing and drainage of liquid wastes separate from the location provided for water servicing and for the loading and unloading of supplies. This area shall be constructed of smooth, nonabsorbent material and graded to drain.
