BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA, AB FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Chapell House, at the corner of Bell and Bugene Streets, more particularly described as:

Beginning at the intersection of the North right-of-way line of Bell Street and the West right-of-way line of Eugene Street, which is the point of beginning, proceed northward along the West right-of-way line of Eugene Street 250 feet; thence proceed due Bast a distance of 350 feet; thence proceed due south a distance of approximately 300 feet. (more or less), to the North right-of imately 300 feet, (more or less), to the North right-of way line of Bell Street; thence proceed Easterly along the North right-of-way line of Bell Street approximately 370 feet to the point of beginning.

is hereby designated, dedicated, and declared to be a Historic District as the same is provided for by Ordinance number 26-67 as authorized by ACT #142 of the Special Session of the Legialature of Alabama of 1967.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
