Event Detail Guidelines

Montgomery Fire/Rescue is dedicated to providing the best services possible to all individuals whether they reside within the city or they are just visiting the city for work, pleasure, and or entertainment. The City of Montgomery sponsors many events within the city that attracts large crowds seeking entertainment through such events as concerts, sporting events, etc.

Medical Assistance Coverage

The following are guidelines established by Montgomery Fire/Rescue that will be utilized to provide adequate medical assistance for all events held within the City of Montgomery. These guidelines will be utilized for any event in which medical assistance is required or requested.

Definitions:

- Medic Detail: Two person medical team with a paramedic, utilizing an ATV, without transport capabilities but with all required equipment to be recognized and operate as an advance life support unit.
- Rescue Unit: Two person medical team with a paramedic, utilizing a Type 1/3 mobile box unit
 with transport capabilities and all required equipment to be recognized and operate as an
 advance life support unit.
- Mobile Command Unit/Rehab: Two person unit that will provide an area for command staff and rehabilitation services.
- Command Unit: District Chief car, which is a one to two person unit that will provide an area of isolation for the Incident Commander.

Event Requirements:

Each event held within the city in which medical services is required or requested will be subject to the following basic guidelines as established by Montgomery Fire/Rescue. Montgomery Fire/Rescue reserves the right to require any additional resources necessary in some circumstances based on but not limited to weather conditions, possible crowd behavior, location, etc.

In order to provide adequate medical services to the public and for safety of the department personnel, each event will be staffed with the proper and efficient number of medical units and personnel as determined by MFR.

- All events with an expected participation of at least 500 (to include staff for the event) will require 1 Medical Detail.
- All events with an expected participation of 500 to 1000 (to include staff for the event) will require 2 Medical Details.

- All events with an expected participation of 1000 to 1500 (to include staff for the event) will require 2 Medical Details and a 1 Rescue Unit.
- Any event with an expected participation of 1500 to 2000 (to include staff for the event) will require 3 Medical Details and a 1 Rescue Unit.
- Any event with an expected participation of 2000 to 2500 (to include staff for the event) will require 4 Medical Details, 1 Rescue Unit, 1 Command Unit.
- Any event with an expected participation of 2000 to 2500 (to include staff for the event) will require 5 Medical Details, 1 Rescue Unit, 1 Command Unit.
- ** An invoice will be provided by Montgomery Fire/Rescue and all fees must be paid within two weeks of the event held.
- ** All request will be honored at the discretion of the Fire Chief.

The following are guidelines established by Montgomery Fire/Rescue that will be utilized to provide adequate water rescue for all events held within the City of Montgomery where there is a danger of an incident in or near the water. These guidelines will be utilized for any event in which water rescue assistance is required or requested.

Definitions:

- 1) Boat 86: 27 Foot Boston Whaler, 500 HP. 12 Person Capacity with a 1250 GPM Fire Pump, and Dive Rescue Capability
- 2) Boat 87: 25 Foot Boston Whaler, 250 HP. 10 Person Capacity and Dive Rescue Capability
- 3) Connector Boat: 16.5 Foot long aluminum flat bottom boat, 70 HP motor with an 8 Person Capacity
- 4) Inflatable Boat: 12 Foot Inflatable with 35 HP motor and a 6 person Capacity
- 5) Wave Runner: 3 Seat Wave Runner that can be equipped with a life sled for rescue purposes.
- 6) PFD: References a Personal Flotation Device worn by civilians participating in public water events
