It's a New Year & a New Chance to Complete Your HRA!

The purpose of the Health Risk Assessment (HRA) is to control healthcare costs and improve employee health by providing valuable insights of four major risk factors - high blood pressure, high cholesterol, high glucose, and obesity. Completing your HRA every year keeps you informed of your health and helps prevent serious illness.

This year's HRA should be completed between January 1st - September 30th

Schedule your "Biometric Screening" appointment with **Premise Health** today!

If you prefer to use your own personal doctor, don't forget to turn your completed **Private Physician form** in to the Benefits Office.

Not completing your HRA by the deadline will result in an additional charge of \$25/pay period for your health insurance in 2024. Employees on the City's Health Plan will receive a letter this month with more information.



How does this work with my health insurance and pharmacy options?

Rx Savings Solutions offers a service that helps lower your prescription drug costs. This service doesn't change anything about your current insurance plan, pharmacy preferences or other benefits. Our software is linked to your health insurance plan information so it can customize ways to lower your out-of-pocket prescription drug costs.

How do I use Rx Savings Solutions when I'm prescribed a new medicine?

Your account has a search feature to compare medication options and prices before your doctor writes a new prescription. Anytime you start taking a new prescription that's covered by your insurance plan, it will automatically show up on your online Rx Savings Solutions account (unless you used a coupon card that takes you outside of insurance). You'll be able to see any options you might have to save money, and you'll receive a message if you're paying too much. Better yet, you can access your account with a mobile device and search for the lowest-cost option at the time your doctor writes the prescription.

Health Plan Deductibles

City Health Plan deductibles start over January 1st

HMP Health Management Plan:

Single Coverage - \$1,500

Family Coverage - \$3,000

Traditional PPO Plan:

Single Coverage - \$300

Family Coverage - \$900

Prescription:

\$250/person (\$750 family maximum)

Dental:

\$25/person (\$75 family maximum)

Preventive Service Benefits

Members enrolled in the City's Health Plan have access to certain preventive screenings and immunizations that are covered by the plan. Preventive services are routine health care that includes screenings, check-ups, and patient counseling to prevent illnesses, disease, or other health problems. Recommended guidelines are provided for men, women, and children based on age and certain risk factors.

Below are common adult preventive services and their frequency/limitations. The full preventive services list can be found **here**.

Preventive Services For Adults	Frequency/Limitations
Preventive Office Visit	One per calendar year
Colorectal Cancer Screening	Age 45-75
- Colonoscopy	Every 10 years
Prostate Screening	Men age 40 and older, one per calendar year
Breast Cancer Mammography Screening	Age 35-39 one baseline, age 40 and older one per calendar year
