

MONTGOMERY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION (HPC)
COMMEMORATIVE PLAQUE APPLICATION

Commemorative plaques are available to owners of 50-year-old, or older, buildings that are locally designated as historic, whether individually or as part of an historic district; any individual property listed on the Alabama Register of Landmarks & Heritage or any contributing structure in an historic district listed on the Alabama Register; and any National Register of Historic Places-listed building or any contributing building within a National Register Historic District.

The cost for a commemorative plaque is \$40. Payment will be requested only after the sign is approved by the HPC.

If the date of construction is not available on a deed or abstract, then you may contact the Montgomery Water Works at (334) 206-1600 to request the date water service was extended to the property; or use the Montgomery County Revenue Commission's Property Tax search (https://isv.kcsgis.com/al.montgomery_revenue/) to find building information.
