Montgomery Military and Veterans Commission Committee Goals and Responsibilities

Montgomery Military and Veterans Committees Executive Committee

- Goals:
 - Provide strategic direction and oversight for all veteran-related initiatives in Montgomery.
 - Ensure strong collaboration between the various committees and subcommittees.
 - Act as a central liaison to the Mayor's Office and other city departments regarding military and veteran affairs.
- Duties:
 - Plan and facilitate meetings
 - Review and approve plans from subcommittees.
 - Advocate for veterans' issues at the local, state, and federal level.

MMVC Veterans Memorial Park Committee

- Goals:
 - Plan and establish a veteran's memorial park in the capital city.
 - Plan to maintain and enhance the beauty and significance of the park.
 - Plan for commemorative events and ceremonies at the park.
 - Develop educational programs to promote awareness of military service and veterans' sacrifices.
- Duties:
 - Identify and procure a location.
 - Design the layout of the park. Include beautification projects (landscaping, clean-up, etc.).
 - Coordinate with local schools and youth groups for park involvement.
 - Plan a capital fundraiser and identify other funding.

MMVC Veterans Day Parade Committee

- Goals:
 - Plan and execute an annual Veterans Day Parade to honor and celebrate veterans of all service branches.
 - Foster a sense of community pride and support for veterans.
- Duties:
 - Secure parade route permits and logistics.
 - Recruit parade participants (veteran's groups, marching bands, local businesses, etc.).
 - Coordinate event promotion and outreach.
 - Secure funding.

MMVC Homeless Veterans Committee (working in conjunction with CHSC)

- Goals:
 - Eliminate homelessness among Montgomery's veteran population.
 - Provide comprehensive support services tailored to veterans' needs.
- Duties:
 - Assist with renovations.
 - Partner with the CHSC to streamline veterans' access to housing, healthcare, and other resources.
 - Conduct outreach to identify and assist homeless veterans.
 - Develop job training and placement programs specifically for veterans.

MMVC Veterans Housing Committee

- Goals:
 - Increase affordable housing options for veterans in Montgomery.
 - Ensure veterans have access to safe and stable housing environments.
- Duties:
 - Collaborate with housing developers and agencies on veteran-specific projects.
 - Advocate for policies that prioritize veterans' housing needs.
 - Assist veterans in navigating housing applications and resources.

MMVC Spouses' Ambassador Program Committee

- Goals:
 - Provide military spouses with resources, guidance, and community connections to smooth their transition to Montgomery.
 - Cultivate a strong sense of support and belonging within the military spouse community.
 - Raise awareness of military culture and the unique needs of military families among the broader Montgomery community.
 - Build a positive reputation for Montgomery as a welcoming and supportive community for military families.
- Duties:
 - Develop detailed policies and procedures for the Ambassador Program (recruitment, training, operations).
 - Liaise with leadership at Maxwell Air Force Base and other military installations in the area.
 - Research best practices from other successful military spouse support programs.
 - Craft compelling narratives about the program's impact for reports, media outreach, and presentations.
 - Regularly communicate program successes to the Commission, stakeholders, and the general public.

MMVC Female Veterans Group

- Goals:
 - Foster a supportive and strong network of female veterans in Montgomery where they can connect, support one another, and create a sense of belonging.
 - Raise awareness of unique challenges faced by female veterans and advocate for policy changes (locally and at a broader level) that improve the lives of women who have served.
 - Provide guidance and assistance on accessing essential resources, such as healthcare, benefits, employment support, and mental health services.
 - Actively engage with female veterans in the community, including those who may be isolated or unaware of existing support, to ensure they feel included and valued.
- Duties:
 - Build relationships with local and national organizations focused on veteran support, women's issues, and relevant service providers to optimize the group's reach and effectiveness.
 - Organize regular workshops, seminars, and speaker events covering topics important to female veterans like benefits navigation, mental health, financial management, and women's health issues.
 - Facilitate regular gatherings for social connection, mentoring, and peer-topeer support, tailored to diverse needs of women veterans.
 - Maintain a clear and accessible communication platform (website, newsletter, social media) to keep members updated on events, resources, and policy news.
