- 3. All participants must register and pay programs fees (when applicable) each semester prior to participation. *Fees are nonrefundable!*
- 4. Some programs are limited in size and are filled on a first come, first serve basis.
- 5. Orientation for all Wellness members and Assessments for After-school participants are required. Please call for an appointment.
- 6. All checks for After-School programs should be payable to MTRC. All checks for Wellness members should be made payable to the City of Montgomery.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

- 6. Remember if you access the site before 9:00am you will need to hit the refresh button before continuing to register.
- 7. Payment must be received by 5:00pm on Friday, August 2, 2024 or your registration will be cancelled.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who can register?

Online registration is for fall semester programs and participants wanting to register for the fall semester. These participants should be able to register from any computer with internet access.

How do we know who registered?

The server will have a clock that measures to the second. Therefore, the online registration company will know who finished registering before 9:00am.

Will anyone be able to register before 9:00am?

NO! The company will not let you register before 9:00am.

What if I don't have a computer?

The MTRC will be open Sat., July 27, 2024, so you may use one of the computers at the center. There will be staff available to assist you with your registration. Fees are due upon registration and you must have a registration form filled out properly.

When are fees due?

All fees are due <u>in full</u> by Friday, August 2, 2024, or your registration will be cancelled.

There will be a \$6.00 registration fee for all fall programs.


