Construction Manager (1 Contract Position)

Job Summary:

The Construction Manager participates in the development of a project-based curriculum and ensures that construction trainers provide quality instruction. This person provides oversight of on-site construction training, ensuring work-site safety, knowledge of safety procedures, and proper construction techniques. The Construction Manager also assists in the evaluation of YouthBuild Montgomery participants' knowledge and skills in construction.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Develop a detailed construction plan and schedule.
- 2. Coordinate and monitor the progress and quality of work.
- 3. Set standards for work-site safety and appropriate behavior.
- 4. Enforce overall safety protocols.
- 5. Participate in the development of a project-based curriculum.
- 6. Ensure quality instruction of all construction skills taught to participants.
- 7. Provide oversight of the on-site construction training.
- 8. Implement and accurately maintain a system to track participants' progress and assess their skills and abilities.
- 9. Assist in the evaluation of participants' knowledge and skills in construction.
- 10. Maintain accurate files documenting the construction projects for each cohort.
- 11. Maintain accurate inventory of all tools, supplies, and equipment.
- 12. Identify possible collaborative partnerships, those willing to work with young adults as construction trainees.
- 13. Collaborate with other program staff regarding participants' progress.
- 14. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- 1. Experience working with at-risk and or justice-involved young adults.
- 2. Ability to teach individuals at various skill levels and with diverse learning styles.
- 3. Compassionate and able to relate to participants.
- 4. Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- 5. Critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- 6. Proficiency in construction software applications (e.g. AutoCAD), classroom technology, and computer-based instruction (e-learning).
- 7. A High School Diploma or Equivalency, a minimum of five (5) years of work experience in construction, and a minimum of two (2) years of supervisory experience.
- 8. Must hold all relevant licenses and certifications associated with teaching to the National Skill Standards.
