Construction Trainer (2 Contract Positions)

Job Summary:

The Construction Trainer prepares and teaches the Pre-Apprenticeship Certification (PACT) curriculum to YouthBuild Montgomery participants. Participants are taught how to properly use and handle hand tools, power tools, and equipment. The Construction Trainer teaches a variety of construction skills and evaluates participants' knowledge.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist in the development of a project-based curriculum.
- 2. Enforce overall safety.
- 3. Teach the proper use and handling of all hand tools, power tools, and equipment.
- 4. Teach construction skills, including demolition, framing, roofing, drywall, carpentry, electrical, plumbing, painting, and masonry.
- 5. Develop learner centered lesson plans.
- 6. Employ teaching strategies and instructional materials for different learning styles.
- 7. Incorporate, as appropriate, current technology in the classroom, distance learning and laboratory environments.
- 8. Create and model a quality learning environment that supports a diverse population.
- 9. Prepare, distribute, and utilize instructional support materials, including course syllabi, supplementary materials, instructional media, and other devices as appropriate.
- 10. Assess participants' mastery of skills through observation and periodic testing.
- 11. Collaborate with other program staff regarding participants' progress.
- 12. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- 1. Experience working with at-risk and or justice-involved young adults.
- 2. Ability to teach individuals at various skill levels and with diverse learning styles.
- 3. Compassionate and able to relate to participants.
- 4. Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- 5. Critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- 6. Proficiency in construction software applications (e.g. AutoCAD), classroom technology, and computer-based instruction (e-learning).
- 7. A High School Diploma or Equivalency and a minimum of five (5) years of work experience in construction.
- 8. Must hold all relevant licenses and certifications associated with teaching to the National Skill Standards.
