ORDINANCE NO. 58-2003

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DIGGING OF WELLS IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF DOWNTOWN MONTGOMERY

WHEREAS, the City of Montgomery is empowered to enact ordinances to protect and to promote the general public health and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City of Montgomery has been cooperating with the Environmental Protection Agency regarding the evaluation and remediation of tetrachloroethene in the Capitol City Plume Site identified in Figure 1-1 and Figure 1.2 as attached and more specifically described as:

An area bordered on the West by the Alabama River, going North along the river to the extension of Goldberg Street, going East along the extension of Goldberg Street to Union Street, going South along Union Street to Washington Avenue, going West along Washington Avenue to Commerce Street, then going Northwest along Commerce Street to the Alabama River.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA, the following ordinance is hereby adopted:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to dig any wells in the site identified as the Capitol City Plume Site.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication, or as otherwise provided by law.
